

How to start a discipleship group guide

Step One: The Invite

<u>Ist</u>: Pray

2nd: Approach and personally ask "7" or (a small group) of students, if they would like to be discipled and be a part of your group. If so, gather their parent's contact info. Next, reach out to their parents to introduce yourself and get permission.

<u>3rd</u>: Establish a location: Home, Park, church, school, Coffee shop, etc.

<u>4th</u>: Familiarize yourself with the "7x7 CONVERSATIONS Discipleship model.

<u>5th</u>: Take advantage of our online 7 x 7 training, resources, and app.

<u>**6th</u>**: Solidify meeting dates and a time/day (preferably the same day of the week for 7 weeks).</u>

<u>7th</u>: Send out a text to your students and parents.

• (Ex) "Hey guys! I'm super excited about our discipleship group! Our first meeting will be this Friday night in my home. Let's meet from 7 to 9:30 PM. Please bring a snack to share and I will provide the drinks!"

Step Two: The Mission

Follow the 7x7 CONVERSATIONS Lesson plan to take students through questions, Biblical answers, and truth that will help them understand why they believe what they believe.
